


Adding Flair with 3s - Part 2

In part 1, you were introduced to the *playing threes* concept. This week, we'll continue developing *threes* coordination and expanding ideas on how to use them around the kit. I'll start with an example from Hotel California – Eagles, which was transcribed by Steve Ley. Then, we'll throw in a couple of fills that fit in context with the *three technique* used.


Threes Example from Hotel California - Eagles

Verse 1 groove leading into the first 4 bars of chorus 1



Expanding The Groove

It's often fun to expand a groove by adding and/or moving bass strokes. Let's take the groove from the first measure from the Hotel California excerpt above (measure 29) and move the bass around. We'll keep the hands the same.
